

Uniform Information

One of the important elements of any high school performing ensemble is the uniform. We are fortunate here at Milton to have professional uniforms for our orchestra members. Below you will find a fee schedule for the rental of uniforms. Please note that this fee reflects a one-time dry-cleaning cost for the end of the year.

The ladies will have long black gowns and the gentlemen will have tuxedos. The gentlemen will have an additional cost for the tuxedo shirt, bow tie, and cummerbund. The shirt, bow tie, and cummerbund are available for purchase at Savvi Formal Wear at North Point Mall and need to be purchased in the next 2-3 weeks (to insure availability). Ladies and gentlemen may incur additional costs for alterations, although every effort has been made to fit them with a uniform that does not require alterations. Dresses should be floor length to cover shoes. All socks and shoes will be black and will be provided by the student.

Note on alterations: Please do not cut or use permanent stitching on either garment. Use a basting hemline on dresses. Remember, these uniforms need to be used for many years and we need to remain flexible for your child's growth and for the use of future students.

The cost of uniform rentals is as follows: Make Check Payable to Milton High School Orchestra:

First year students (all freshmen) -	\$100.00 (Gown/Tux)
Second year students -	35.00
Third and fourth year students -	25.00
Tuxedo shirt (student purchase) -	15.99 (approx)
Bow tie/cummerbund -	9.99 (approx)

All fittings have been completed. Each student is responsible for the uniform during the duration of the school year. The student will be held responsible for replacement costs if the uniform is not returned in good, wearable condition. At the end of the school year, all uniforms will be returned within five days of the last concert or performance given by the student (must be an MHS related performance). DO NOT dry clean your uniform before turning it in; the cost for cleaning is included in the yearly uniform fee.
